ENJOY THE SUN SAFELY!

Textiles are the most efficient way to protect your skin. It is important to know your skin type to determine your self-protection time (period of time in direct sun exposure with no damage to the skin).

The Ultraviolet Protection Factor (e.g. Protect 80) defines the factor by which your self protection time can be extended simply by wearing textiles.

E.g. Skin Type 2: UPF 80 x self protection time 10 min = 800 min protection/day

SKIN	very fair-skinned	fair-skinned	light/dark brown	light brown, olive
HAIR	red or blond	blond, brown	light brown, brown	dark brown/black

SUNBURNS	always heavy, aching	mostly heavy, aching	less frequently, moderate	hardly ever
SELF-PROTECTION TIME OF SKIN	5 - 10 minutes	10 - 20 minutes	20 - 30 minutes	40 minutes

REMARK: Skin Type 5 & 6 are not listed here as they show no risk of erythema.
